Women make up 46.6% of the total workforce in the U.S., but in the construction industry, the statistics are drastically different. Of all construction workers, the Bureau of Labor Statistics reported that 10.9% of them are women. So, for every 10 people in a construction-related role, one of them is a woman (U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, 2020).
